



"The Man"

Scot Cameron, the third of four sons to William and Constance Moore, was born April 20, 1964, in Mount Vernon, New York. He spent most of his life in Mount Vernon but also resided in South Carolina and Washington, DC.

A single mom in what he refers to as a "Christian-like environment" raised Scot and his brothers. His mom was adamant about them attending Sunday school and church and doing what was right. Raising four boys under one roof made some interesting times, to say the least. Even so, it was not a hindrance to her doing a wonderful job raising them.

At age 13, Scot received the call to ministry but did not want to preach and decided to keep it to himself. The next year someone publicly prophesied that he was called to preach, driving him to push further away from the truth he already knew. He held that knowledge inside and went about life in a manner typical of the average teenaged boy. He graduated high school with honors and matriculated to Hofstra University, where he earned a Bachelor's degree in Computer Science. As the years passed he tried to forget about the call on his life, but God had not forgotten. By age 22, the conviction was so unbearable that he shared his struggle with an older preacher who advised, "All you have to do is yield to the calling." He did not want to yield. He did not want to accept the call.

The constant wrestling with God and being plain old tired of hearing people say he was called to preach was too much. He finally conceded but told God if he really wanted him to preach He would have to make it plain. God woke him up at 5 o'clock the next morning and dealt with him for two hours. First taking him to task and then to Scripture where his calling is from...Isaiah 42:6-9, "I the Lord have called thee in righteousness, and will hold thine hand and will keep thee, and give thee for a covenant of the people for a light of the Gentiles..."














First Lady: Sharon R. Moore



On February 14, 1987, Scot married his high school sweetheart and love of his life, Sharon Renee. The couple relocated to the Washington-Metropolitan area and there began building a life and immersed themselves in the ministry of the A.M.E. Zion Church.

Mrs. Sharon Moore had no idea that her husband had been called to preach. Scot had never told her about his previous experience and now had to explain to her that he had a call on his life to preach. Her response was, "I did not marry a preacher," but once ministry began, she was fine with it.

Upon learning that his call was also to pastor, her initial response was, "I did not marry a pastor." However, she actually embraced the call, catching hold of the vision and becoming a first lady sooner than he became a pastor. From then until now, it has been amazing watching her flourish as

the First Lady of Judah.

During the 167th Session of the Philadelphia and Baltimore Annual Conference Rev. Moore received a paper appointment.



On Sunday, July 8, 2001, Bishop Williams prayed and anointed the ground during Ground Breaking Ceremony.




We honor the life of Bishop Williams for he was very instrumental in the birth, development and growth of Judah Temple.











Our First Service







On August 18, 1996, Judah Temple A.M.E. Zion Church held its first worship service, in the cafeteria of Thomas Pullen Middle School, and became "A Church With a Heart of Praise and a Mind To Serve." Pastor Moore pronounced, "This reflects the direction where God wants us to go." From that beginning, Judah has followed God's desire to give Him praise and worship.



Many of the original Judah Temple congregation started with Full Gospel A.M.E. Zion Church members who became Associate Members and provided support for this new ministry during its first year. The church started to grow as people from all over the Metropolitan area began to join. By December 1996, our new church had over 120 active members.

First Anniversary


Our 1st Anniversary was held at the Sheraton Wardman Park Hotel in Washington DC.







Youth Pastor









As a key educational arm of Judah Temple, Judah U seeks to promote growth in all areas of life. From traditional Sunday School to foundational biblical principles to biblical studies to evangelism to spiritual warfare to life application principles to finances, Judah U's goal is to equip persons to walk in the ways of

God. Since its inception Judah U has offered classroom and online classes. We have been blessed to see hundreds of persons enroll in Judah U classes over the years, and we continue to receive testimonials of how Judah U has transformed many lives. To God Be The Glory!



W.E.L.L.

(Worshippers Excelling in Learning and Living)

As the membership grew, Pastor Moore wanted to ensure that the members of Judah felt connected to the church. In January 2010, he implemented the W.E.L.L. (Worshippers Excelling in Learning and Living) Small Group Ministry. W.E.L.L. Groups provide spiritual growth activities for persons who desire to become worshippers excelling in learning and living, by walking together with one another through study, prayer, worship, fellowship and outreach.



Judah Outreach Center

In August 2010, Judah extended its outreach into the Baltimore area and launched the Judah Outreach Center located in Baltimore, Maryland. Fulfilling the mission of Judah Temple, To Know, Grow, Go, and Show the Love of Jesus, we have made a great impact in this community.

During our early bible studies and discipleship classes, we have had individuals who were homeless, drunk, addicted to drugs, and some just simply unruly. However challenging

these persons may have been, it was truly a blessing to those of us working at the center.



At the Judah Outreach center we have established many opportunities to make deposits in the lives of those in the neighborhood.

Through our annual Thanksgiving and Christmas dinners, we have fed thousands of people including seniors, homeless, children, and many families that are financially unable to make ends meet. We have an annual Mother's Day Fellowship that focuses on ministering to young mothers and single mothers. This is always a tremendous blessing. The outreach center is a true blessing to everyone in the community. We offer Father's Day Fellowships, Black History observations, Young Boys Lock-ins, P.E.A.R.L.S. (a 12 week program for tween females), Door to Door Outreach, Summer Camps, Baptisms, the clothing center, and weekly discipleship classes.

In January of 2013, we began having services at the Judah Outreach Center. Many of the

families and individuals being ministered to at JOC decided to become a part of the Judah

Temple Family. This has become the Judah Temple North location where we have "Saturday Night Live" services every Saturday evening at 6:00pm.

We are encouraged by the membership at Judah Outreach Center and believing God is going to bless many more people through the ministry in Baltimore.

Judah Prep

Judah Prevention, Resource and Enrichment Program (P.R.E.P.) officially launched in 2014. Prior to 2014, the program operated under the Youth Ministry of Judah Temple. A team of educators came together based on a core belief in strengthening our community by investing in the youth through educational opportunities and created the program.



The mission of Judah P.R.E.P. is to provide life management, career and educational excellence training for students. Our mission is accomplished through tutoring students in grades K-12 and providing resources and information needed to complete each phase of school. Students are enriched with knowledge beyond the classroom in areas such as work etiquette, life skills training and development of their own innate talents. Judah P.R.E.P. is staffed by volunteers that provide tutoring, mentorship and hospitality services.







Young Adult Ministry

In the summer of 2012, Judah appointed its first Young Adult Pastor, Rev. Tamika Jackson. With a steadily growing population of 22-40 year old members, Pastor Moore recognized the importance of ministry designed specifically for young adults. Since that time, the Judah Temple Young Adult Ministry (JTYAM) has provided an "open Christian environment in which young adults can navigate life's situations while building and developing stronger relationships with Christ and with each other."









The Young Adult Ministry is committed to developing Christian disciples using unique and creative tools. The monthly Waffles & the Word Bible Study combines faith, food, and fellowship in a way that ministers to the mind, body, and spirit. The quarterly young adult worship experience, G.R.O.W. (a Generation Redefining Our Worship), is designed to help us think outside the box in terms of how we worship God.







The members of JTYAM consistently strive to live up to their theme scripture found in 2 Peter 1: by growing in their faith and showing that what they know about the Lord Jesus Christ has made their lives both useful and meaningful.


